

BYLAWS OF CZECH JUMP ROPE, z.s.

Art. 1

1.1 Name: Czech Jump Rope, z. s. (hereinafter referred to as "Czech Jump Rope")

1.2 Legal status: Czech Jump Rope is a self-governing and voluntary association

1.3 Seat: Prague

Art. 2

PURPOSE, MAIN AND EXTERNAL ACTIVITY

2.1 Main activity and purpose

- a. Organization and operation of jump rope (rope skipping) in all its forms in the Czech Republic.
- b. Performing the role of an umbrella organization for jump rope (rope skipping) in the Czech Republic.
- c. Developing jump rope (rope skipping) in the Czech Republic.
- d. Creating conditions for the sport of jump rope (rope skipping) and supporting its members and especially the youth.
- e. Preparation and organization of important sports events at national and international level.
- f. Support for the training of coaches, judges and athletes.
- g. Promoting jump rope (rope skipping) and promoting its interests in dealing with partner national and international organizations.
- h. Developing international co-operation.
- i. Cooperation with the Anti-Doping Committee of the Czech Republic and promotion of sport purity and adherence to anti-doping rules in accordance with the World Anti-Doping Code.
- j. Enforcing and adherence to fair play principles.
- k. Cooperating with the International Jump Rope Union (IJRU) as the only umbrella international organization of the sport of jump rope (rope skipping).

2.2. Secondary activity

Czech Jump Rope can only support its main activities to carry out ancillary economic activity consisting of doing business or other profit-gaining activity, thereby creating an economic base for fulfilling its purpose.

Art. 3

MEMBERSHIP

3.1

Membership in Czech Jump Rope is voluntary. Czech Jump Rope members may be a legal entity or individuals, as a result of their decision, who identify with purpose and philosophy of Czech Jump Rope and who wish to participate in the fulfillment of common interests with other members. There are different kinds of membership. Different membership rights and responsibilities are linked to different kinds of membership. There is no legal complaint to membership in Czech Jump Rope.

3.2

Membership in Czech Jump Rope is distinguished as follows:

- Collective
- Registered
- Individual
- Affiliated
- Honorary

3.3 Collective member

The collective member can be a legal entity (club, team or a group with a legal entity) that associates citizens actively engaged in the sport of jump rope and its forms (hereinafter referred to as the "team"). The Czech Jump Rope Executive Committee decides on admission of a collective member on the basis of the submitted

application. Part of the registration is also the provision of basic identification data for the applicant and his commitment to comply with Czech Jump Rope bylaws and other standards and to submit to the Czech Jump Rope decision. The regulations of the collective member must comply with Czech Jump Rope standards. A team representative must be a member of the team, must be over 18 years of age and communicates through a dedicated e-mail. The team representative and the email can be changed.

3.4 Registered Member

The registered member is an individual, who is actively engaged in jump rope (rope skipping) through his membership in a team that is a collective member of Czech Jump Rope at the time of registration. Part of the registration is mainly providing of personal data of the applicant and his commitment to comply with the bylaws and other Czech Jump Rope standards and to submit to the Czech Jump Rope decision. The registered member submits his registration application (application form) through a member representative designated by the collective member. The requirements for registration (applications) may be regulated by an internal regulation.

3.5 Individual member

An individual member is an individual, who is not a member of a sports club or a team, based on the filled application. Part of the registration is in particular providing personal data of the applicant and his commitment to comply with the bylaws and other Czech Jump Rope standards and to submit to the Czech Jump Rope decision. The Czech Jump Rope Executive Committee decides to accept an individual member.

3.6 Affiliated Member

An affiliated member may become a legal entity, who, for whatever reason, does not want or can not become a collective member, but is interested in participating in the activities of Czech Jump Rope and contributing to the fulfillment of its purpose. The Executive Committee Czech Jump Rope decides on the membership.

3.7 Honorary Member

An honorary member can only become an individual, who has made a significant contribution to the development of jump rope (rope skipping). Czech Jump Rope General Meeting decides to grant honorary membership on the recommendation of the Czech Jump Rope Executive Committee. The Honorary Member is relieved of the obligation to pay Czech Jump Rope registration and membership fees. Removal of Honorary Membership is decided by the General Meeting on the recommendation of the Czech Jump Rope Executive Committee.

3.8 Membership registration

Czech Jump Rope records its members in an electronic database. The Czech Jump Rope Executive Committee is responsible for proper records. Registration, deletions and other acts related to the registration of members, including the determination of the extent of the data of the registered members, are stipulated in the internal regulation. Data on Czech Jump Rope members can be made available to the necessary extent of the umbrella organization that is Czech Jump Rope as a member of the sports organization in the framework of fulfilling its obligations towards this organization. They may also be made available to the state administration and local authorities, in particular in connection with applications for grants or other contributions from the state or public budget. Every interested party - a person who is a member of Czech Jump Rope, by filing the application agrees to make the data kept in the members' register accessible. Every interested party - a collective member also confirms that it informed his members and has fulfilled the relevant legal obligations with regard to the processing of personal data with the conditions of keeping records of members of Czech Jump Rope and the extent of the recorded data.

3.9 Membership

The commencement of a membership is incompetence of the Czech Jump Rope Executive Committee. Membership is established by the confirmation of membership application in Czech Jump Rope and delivery of necessary data according to internal regulations.

3.10 Suspension of membership

Membership in Czech Jump Rope is suspended for members in the event of a serious violation of the Czech Jump Rope statutes and regulations, in the event of damage to the reputation of Czech Jump Rope and in case of non-fulfillment of financial obligations to Czech Jump Rope when the member was called to settle its

financial obligations to Czech Jump Rope within a reasonable period of 14 days from the demonstrable delivery of this notice. Collective and registered members have suspended membership rights, including the right to vote on the decisions of the Czech Jump Rope General Assembly, until the settlement of their financial obligations to Czech Jump Rope.

3.11 Termination of membership

Membership in Czech Jump Rope expires:

- a. The dissolution or liquidation of a collective member
- b. The death of an individual, honorary or registered member
- c. By deleting the member on the basis of the decision of the Czech Jump Rope Executive Committee that breach of the obligations of the member resulting from Czech Jump Rope was committed
- d. Exclusion by the Executive Committee's decision for particularly serious misconduct incompatible with the Czech Jump Rope, especially for criminal activities, disciplinary offenses and violations of anti-doping rules or fair-play rules
- e. At the written request of a member

In the event of membership termination, there is no entitlement to refund of registration and membership fees. The termination of membership is without prejudice to the obligation to repay the loan, the return of Czech Jump Rope, or the obligation to properly charge and, if necessary, to refund the subsidy granted from the state or other public budget or other special subsidies.

Art. 4

RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF MEMBERS

Each member has the right to enjoy all the benefits and rights arising from the statutes and membership of Czech Jump Rope. Each member has the duty to act according to the statutes and internal directives and to follow the decisions of the General Jump Rope General Assembly and the Executive Committee of Czech Jump Rope or other Czech Jump Rope bodies. The scope of membership rights and obligations is defined based on the membership type. Entities associated in Czech Jump Rope retain the independence of their legal status, assets and activities.

4.1 Membership rights that belong to all members:

- a. to participate in the activities of Czech Jump Rope and to use its services, unless this right is restricted by another regulation or decision.
- b. Apply their opinions and submit suggestions to Czech Jump Rope
- c. be informed of the activities of Czech Jump Rope
- d. participate in meetings of the Czech Jump Rope organs where the activity or behavior of the member is discussed
- e. participate in competitions, trainings, seminars and other events organized by the association
- f. terminate its membership in Czech Jump Rope.

4.2 Membership rights that belong to the collective members

- a. Participate in the Czech Jump Rope General Assembly and vote on its decisions, through its representative
- b. participate in the Czech Jump Rope management
- c. to participate at the election of bodies of Czech Jump Rope under the terms of these statutes
- d. submit proposals for candidates to the Czech Jump Rope bodies

4.3 Membership rights that belong to individual members

- a. Participate in the Czech Jump Rope General Assembly with an advisory voice;
- b. Submit proposals for candidates to the Czech Jump Rope bodies

4.4 Membership rights to honorary members

- a. Participate in the Czech Jump Rope General Assembly and vote on its decisions with one ballot
- b. submit proposals for candidates to Czech Jump Rope bodies

4.5 The duties of the members are:

- a. to contribute to the development of jump rope (rope skipping)

- b. participate according to their capabilities and capabilities to fulfill the purposes and main activities of Czech Jump Rope
- c. observe the statutes and other internal standards of Czech Jump Rope
- d. adhere to the basic standards of sporting behavior
- e. to comply with resolutions and other decisions of the Czech Jump Rope bodies
- f. to pay duly and in due time membership fees and other fees related to membership and activities in Czech Jump Rope
- g. to maintain credible and verifiable records of their members and to provide relevant statistical data
- h. Properly perform the tasks and functions in which he / she was elected or commissioned
- ch. to cooperate in financial settlement of subsidies from public sources.

Art. 5

CZECH JUMP ROPE BODIES

5.1

The Czech Jump Rope bodies consist of: the General Assembly as the highest authority and the Executive Committee as executive and statutory body. The Audit Commission as the supervisory body and the Commission as auxiliary bodies can be set up on the basis of the General Assembly's decision.

5.2 General Assembly

The General Assembly is the ultimate body of Czech Jump Rope. The scope of authority of the General Assembly includes:

- a. Approval of statutes and their changes.
- b. Ratification of members' membership approved by the Executive Committee.
- c. Election of members of the Executive Committee, the Audit Commission and other commissions. PER ROLLAM vote is possible.
- d. Approval or rejection of decisions of the Executive Committee.
- e. Authorization of the Executive Committee and other authorities to perform a particular task or fulfill a particular task.
- f. Approval of the amount and due date of membership fees.
- g. Decisions on dispositions with real estate Czech Jump Rope.
- h. Right of being notified about the financial results of Czech Jump Rope.
- i. Decision on a member's proposal to review suspension of membership or exclusion.
- j. Creation and termination of commissions, assisting bodies, appointing and dismissing members of these committees.
- k. Supervision of compliance with statutes and other standards of Czech Jump Rope.
- l. Discussion and approval of the Executive Committee's report.
- m. Decision to dissolve Czech Jump Rope or other decisions that will result in the cessation of Czech Jump Rope.

5.2.1 Participants of the General Assembly

The General Assembly participants are representatives of the collective members, members of the Executive Committee, members of the Audit Commission, honorary members, individual members and guests invited by the Executive Committee. The right to vote belongs only to representatives of collective members and honorary members.

A collective member is represented by a delegate and one other member of the team. Each collective member has the right to vote according to the following coefficient:

- In the case of the number of registered members of up to 20 persons, one voting right,
- In the case of the number of registered members from 21 to 40 persons, two voting rights
- In the case of the number of registered members of more than 40 persons, three voting rights.

A delegate may delegate the right to represent a team to another member of the team who is 18 year old or above by the power of attorney. The power of attorney may only be designated for a particular meeting of the General Assembly and must be submitted no later than the start of General Assembly. Members of the

Executive Committee are required to attend a General Assembly with a minimum of three people. A member of the Executive Committee may vote at the General Assembly as a delegate of a team. The General Assembly' quorum requires the presence of members with majority voting rights. The decision of the General Assembly is adopted by a majority vote.

At the constituent General Assembly, each founding member has one voting right, regardless of the type of membership.

5.2.2 Convening the General Assembly

The General Assembly is convened by the Executive Committee of Czech Jump Rope. Between the date of sending invitations and the date of the General Assembly must be at least 3 weeks. The invitation should include the date, time, venue and program items.

The regular General Assembly is called by written electronic invitation no later than 12 months from the date of the last regular General Assembly. At the written request of at least two-thirds of Czech Jump Rope members, the Committee shall be obliged to convene an extraordinary General Assembly within one month of the receipt of the request.

5.2.3 The General Assembly Proceedings

More detailed guideline regarding the General Assembly proceedings may be defined by an internal regulation.

5.3 Czech Jump Rope Executive Committee

The Executive Committee is primarily responsible for:

- a. Approval, suspension, exclusion and deletion of members
- b. Management of Czech Jump Rope affairs and provision for the main and secondary activities of Czech Jump Rope in the periods between the General Assembly
- c. Adoption of directives, regulations and standards
- d. Decisions on dispositions of movable property of Czech Jump Rope
- e. Submission of the results to the General Assembly, preparation of the documents for the General Assembly
- f. Supervision compliance with statutes and other Czech Jump Rope standards
- g. Cooperation with state administration and self-government bodies, cooperation with partners and institutions of which Czech Jump Rope is a member or with whom he cooperates
- h. Decision on the seat of Czech Jump Rope
- i. Decision on all matters, unless they are entrusted by the statutes to exclusive powers of the General Assembly.

5.3.1

The Czech Jump Rope Executive Committee consists of five members. It consists of a president, two vice-presidents and two members of the committee. The method of election of the Committee shall be determined by the Electoral Code. The election of the statutory body can be carried out in justified cases PER ROLLAM. The President and Vice-Presidents are elected by the General Assembly directly to the individual functions. The term of office of the Committee is three years (36 months).

5.3.2

The Executive Committee is the statutory body of Czech Jump Rope. The President, Vice-Presidents and members of the Executive Committee are entitled to act on behalf of Czech Jump Rope separately in the field of business matters. Legal acts for Czech Jump Rope are made by members of the Executive Committee always by signing two of their members, with their name and their statutory function. At meetings, they are bound by the decision of the General Assembly and the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee's quorum is the presence of an absolute majority of its members. The Executive Committee decides / adopts resolutions by an absolute majority of the votes of the present members; in the case of equality of votes, the President's vote is decisive. For the voting, it is also possible to use the institute of correspondence or electronic voting (PER ROLLAM) of all members of the Executive Committee.

5.3.3

Executive Committee member can only be a person over 18 years of age with full legal capability and integrity.

5.3.4

Executive Committee decides in agreement on all matters of Czech Jump Rope that are not entrusted to the General Assembly.

5.3.5

If a member of the Executive Committee resigns, Executive Committee may replace him by co-optation till the end of the term. Co-opting is subject to General Assembly's approval at the next meeting.

5.3.6

Only members may propose candidates for Czech Jump Rope Executive Committee. The name of the candidates must be submitted to the members at least 14 days before the General Assembly. During the General Assembly, a General Assembly VH participant may also nominate a candidate verbally, only if no candidate has been nominated in advance to be elected by the elected bodies. For the standard election, the order of elections is as follows: president, two vice-presidents, two Executive Committee members.

In the event that one seat is elected and only one candidate is nominated, the candidate is elected, if he or she has obtained an absolute majority of votes. If there are several candidates, the candidate with the highest number of votes is elected.

5.4 Audit Commission

5.4.1

The Audit Commission supervises that Czech Jump Rope matters are properly conducted and that Executive Committee performs its activities in accordance with legal regulations, statutes or other internal regulations of Czech Jump Rope.

5.4.2

The Audit Commission has three members. The membership of the Audit Commission is not compatible with the function of the statutory body, nor with the performance of the liquidator function.

5.4.3

The term of office is three years.

5.4.4

The Audit Commission elects a Chairperson acting on its behalf in relation to the Czech Jump Rope authorities and Czech Jump Rope members.

5.4.5

The controlling activity is carried out by the Audit Commission on the basis of its plan or serious initiative from other Czech Jump Rope bodies or Czech Jump Rope members. Within the scope of the Audit Commission, its authorized member may consult the necessary documents and request explanations from the other bodies of Czech Jump Rope, from member bodies or employees.

5.4.6

The Audit Commission shall be responsible in particular for:

- a. Control of the Czech Jump Rope management.
 - b. Control of the use of subsidies or other specific means provided by the state budget or other public budgets.
- The Audit Commission is entitled to control both the Czech Jump Rope itself and its members in the event that these public budget subsidies were provided through Czech Jump Rope.

5.4.7

If the Audit Commission finds deficiencies, it shall notify the Executive Committee without undue delay and the General Assembly at its next meeting.

5.5 Commissions

5.5.1

The creation and cancellation of commissions as auxiliary bodies of Czech Jump Rope, the appointment and removal of members of these committees is under the authority of the Czech Jump Rope Executive Committee.

5.5.2

The Commission serves to develop the activities of Czech Jump Rope in individual areas.

5.5.3

The Commission will be created or canceled according to the needs of Czech Jump Rope. The Commission can be created for both short and long-term tasks.

Art. 6

CZECH JUMP ROPE INTERNAL REGULATIONS

6.1

The highest regulation of Czech Jump Rope are these Statutes which are superior to all other regulations.

6.2

Czech Jump Rope internal regulations supplement the Czech Jump Rope statutes and may not be in conflict with any part of the bylaws or contrary to the decisions of the General Assembly.

6.3

The internal regulations are issued by the Czech Jump Rope Executive Committee.

Art. 7

COMMUNICATION

7.1

Mutual official communication between individual members and bodies of Czech Jump Rope takes place via electronic communication in the form of e-mails, exclusively via the provided official e-mail addresses of the Czech Jump Rope electronic registration system.

7.2

A regulation or other notification sent by e-mail is considered as delivered the day following its dispatch. The day of delivery is considered as the first day of the due date.

7.3

The Executive Committee reserves the right to require members of Czech Jump Rope to send predefined documents by registered post to the official address of Czech Jump Rope.

7.4

By decision of the Czech Jump Rope Executive Committee it is possible to vote per rollam by e-mail. Unless otherwise stated in the motion for a vote, a vote shall be held for a period of 7 days from delivery of the proposal. Voting per rollam may be attended by those who are entitled to vote on a physical vote. For the validity of an email vote, an absolute majority of the members of the organ must take part, in the case of a vote of the General Assembly, an absolute majority of the teams - collective members. For the adoption of the proposal, the proposal must obtain an absolute majority of the votes unless otherwise specified for a particular vote. Voting is understood as consent, disagreement or abstention.

Art. 8

PRINCIPLES OF MANAGEMENT

8.1

The main source of Czech Jump Rope assets are:

- a. Membership fees
- b. Revenues generated in connection with the main activity of Czech Jump Rope, especially in connection with the organization of sport and educational activities
- c. Income from secondary activity operating to support the principal business
- d. Subsidies and contributions from the state budget or other public budgets, grants, etc.
- e. Contributions and subsidies of umbrella or international organizations
- f. Other members' fees
- g. Donations

8.2

All receipts and expenses of the association must be recorded in the accounting book. All payment items must be specified for each item. At least once a year, Czech Jump Rope must be audited by the Audit Commission if it is set up. For control purposes, the Executive Committee is required to provide members of the Audit Commission with co-operation and to enable them to carry out audit work.

8.3

The membership fees, their amount and maturity are proposed by the Czech Jump Rope Executive Board and approved by the Czech Jump Rope General Assembly.

8.4

Czech Jump Rope assets is owned by Czech Jump Rope as a whole. The Czech Jump Rope Executive Committee decides on the transfer of ownership of the property in addition to immovable property, its acquisition and disappearance and all other dispositions with it. The General Assembly decides on all dispositions of immovable property.

8.5

Liquidation: In the event of dissolution of Czech Jump Rope without a legal successor, liquidation will be carried out for the purpose of settlement of assets. The Liquidator is appointed by the General Assembly. The liquidation balance after liquidation can be used for public benefit purposes, with priority being offered to Czech Jump Rope members. If Czech Jump Rope has received assigned subsidy from a state or other public budget, the liquidator shall dispose the relevant part of the liquidation balance, according to the decision of the competent authority of the provider of this purpose-assigned subsidy.

Art. 9

FINAL PROVISIONS

These Statutes were approved on 2 November 2018 by the General Jump Rope General Assembly and entered into force on the date of entry in the Public Register. The President of Czech Jump Rope is authorized to register Czech Jump Rope in the public register.
